"We are a small, tight-knit community, so being able to offer students from our local high school a scholarship to help them further their education whether it be at a university, community college or trade school is important to us," said Mulvihill, "When we started this we were only able to give scholarships to a few seniors, and this year we are giving out \$4,500. Now, with TPC Colorado as a partner, we're looking forward to growing the tournament to offer even more graduating senior scholarships."
